## May Day Tree

Zone:	3	Height:	30'
Spread:	20'	Shape:	Compact & Round
Growth Rate:	Medium	Fall Color:	Yellow to Bronze Red

Description: Related to the chokecherry, is drought resistant with low to medium water needs. It tolerates well-drained alkaline soils. This tree grows in full sun or partial shade. Clusters of fragrant white flowers appear in May after leaf break. Bark is gunmetal grey.

# Kentucky Coffee Tree

## Kentucky Coffee Tree

Zone:	4-8	Height:	50' - 60'
Spread:	40'-50'	Shape:	Oval
Growth Rate:	Slow	Fall Color:	Yellow
		Foliage:	Bluish-green

Description: This tree has large, double compound leaves. It has a bold outline and silvery twigs that give it added winter interest.

# Bur Oak



QUERCUS MACROCARPA

## Bur Oak

Zone:	3 -8	Height:	60' - 80'
Spread:	60' - 80'	Shape:	Rounded, open
Growth Rate:	Slow	Fall Color:	Yellow/Brown

Description: The bur oak has a large broad crown and thick corky bark. It has glossy green fiddle shaped leaves that are 5 to 8 inches long. It will tolerate urban conditions.



# Profusion Crab

## Profusion Crab

Zone:	4 - 7	Height:	15' - 20'
Spread:	30'	Shape:	Rounded
Flower Color:	Purple-red w/pink center	Fruit:	Oxblood red

Description: Abundance of deep red buds that open to purple-red flowers, then fade to lavender. Foliage emerges purple, then fades to bronze-green. Fruit is oxblood red.

# Canada Red Select Cherry



PRUNUS VIRGINIANA 'Canada Red'

## Canada Red Select Cherry

Zone:	2 - 6	Height:	20' - 25'
Spread:	20'	Shape:	Oval, rounded
Flower Color:	White	Fall Color:	Golden yellow
		Foliage Color:	Dark Red

Description: Vigorous growth, straight trunk and uniform top. Foliage is a darker red, with a thick leaf texture. Should have good drainage and aeration.

# Newport Plum



*Prunus cerasifera* 'Newport'

## **Newport Plum**

Zone:	3	Height:	15
Spread:	10	Shape:	Vase
Growth Rate:	Medium	Foliage:	Purple, red

Description: This is a little hardy than other tree forms of flowering plum and it does well where there are extremes of climate. It is one of the early blooming varieties and has a nice glossy reddish purple colored leaf.

# Prairie Expedition American Elm

**Prairie Expedition® American Elm**

Zone:	3-9	Height:	55'
Spread:	60'	Shape:	Rounded, Vase
Growth Rate:	Fast	Foliage:	Dark green

Description: Incredibly tough and cold hardy. Displaying a high resistance to Dutch Elm disease, it averages three to four feet of growth annually. Will provide quick shade in a variety of locations from cold prairies to harsh urban environments.

# Swiss Stone Pine

## **Swiss Stone Pine**

Zone:	3-7	Height:	20'
Spread:	10	Shape:	Pyramidal
Growth Rate:	Slow	Foliage:	Light Green

Description: Very handsome, somewhat slow growing pine. A narrow upright pyrmid in youth, becoming open with spreading drooping branches when mature. Makes an interesting specimen.

# Bosnian Pine



*Pinus leucodermis*

## **Bosnian Pine**

Zone:	4-7	Height:	15'
Spread:	8'	Shape:	Pyramidal
Growth Rate:	Moderate	Foliage:	Dark Green

Description: A beautiful, slow growing tree with a densely branched, pyramidal form and short, glossy, dark green needles. An added attraction are young, purple/blue cones.

# Austrian Pine



*Pinus nigra*

## **Austrian Pine**

Zone: 4-7  
Spread: 15 - 25'  
Growth Rate: Moderate

Height: 30 - 50'  
Shape: Rounded to Oval  
Foliage: Green

Description: A fast growing, broad evergreen with thick dark brown bark and wide spreading branches. Moderate long needles are dark shiny green. A very popular and hardy tree for our area! Perfect for privacy screens and wind breaks.
